### ***4- Contact local MPs to raise concern about plastic***

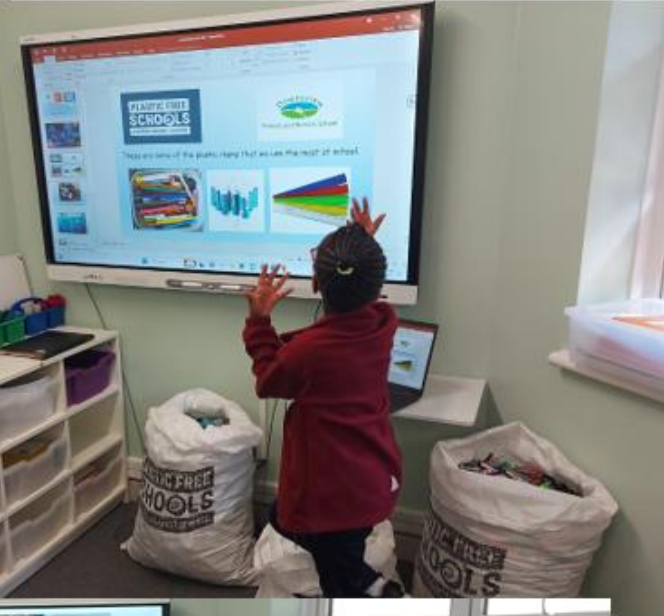
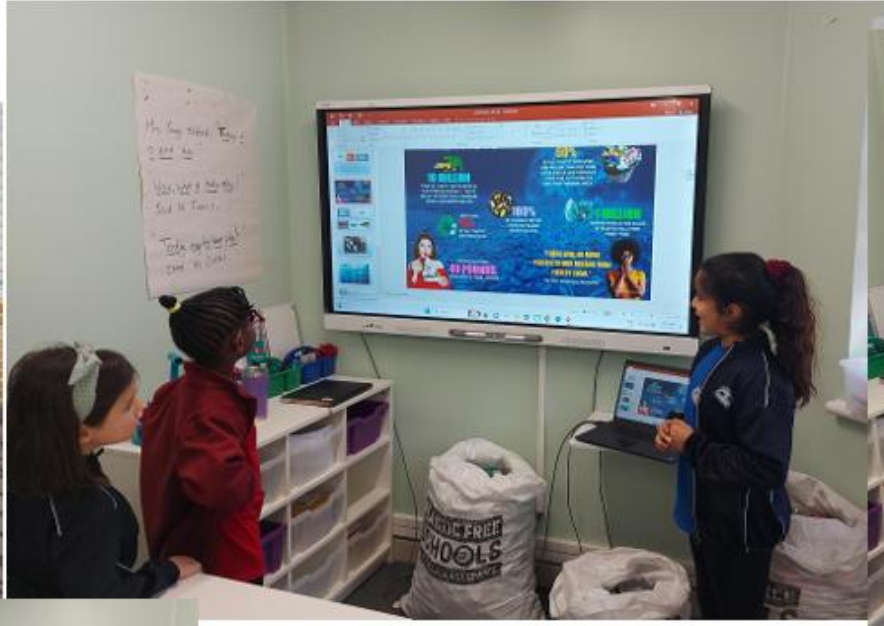
