WHAT WILL BE COVERED?

- Understanding pilot holes, screw sizes, screwdriver bits, and counter-sinking
- Clamping techniques and assembly methods (screwing, nailing)
- Sanding techniques and sandpaper grades
- Accurate measuring with a tape measure
- Basics of joining, planning, and finishing projects
- Knowledge of wood types, grains, knots, and plywood
- Creative woodworking through art-based projects
- Learning woodworking terms and fostering appreciation for trees

Note: With a mix of pre-planned and free-build sessions, kids can get creative and take projects home. Some weeks focus on skill-building and confidence instead.

WHAT CAN PARTICIPANTS MAKE?

At our 10-week Creative Build Club, children bring their ideas to life—animals, vehicles, decorative pieces, or practical items. They use inspiration from home and enjoy a mix of planned projects, games, art skills, and free-build time.

Returning kids will always find fresh, exciting challenges to explore.

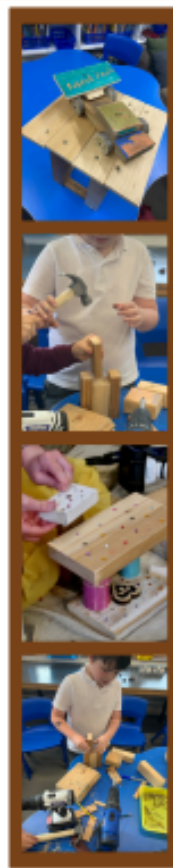
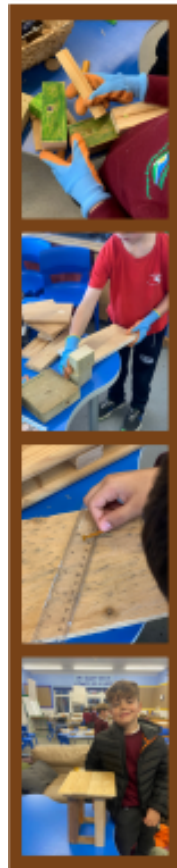

MINECRAFT CODING CLUB

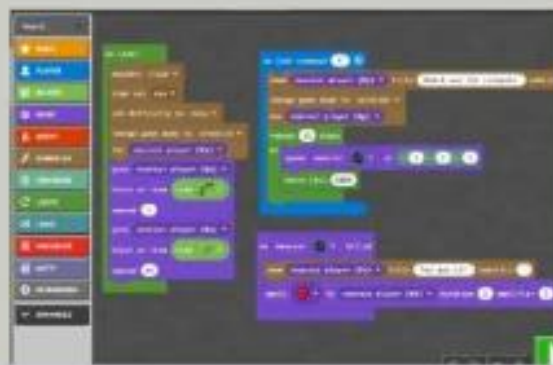
