CURRICULUM



We follow the EYFS statutory framework, and we are committed to the principles within it.

Our approach is to personalise learning through observations of pupils, we follow the interests of individuals or groups, when appropriate. Classrooms are divided into different areas of learning, the children are encouraged to be independent learners and access the whole curriculum with adult support. We aim to ensure all pupils have opportunities to develop and demonstrate the characteristics of effective learning to meet all needs.

SETTLING IN



All of our Nursery and Reception children will be invited into school with their parents before they start in September. This is an opportunity for staff to get to know each child's needs and also to introduce the children to their new environment. These sessions also provides an opportunity to share information and discuss any concerns you may have. You will also be asked to complete our Admissions forms before the summer holidays, in readiness for the start of the Autumn Term.



The children have daily access to the outside area, where we plan for further learning experiences.

LUNCH



Lunch menus are very popular with a range of well-balanced and healthy options and are changed regularly. All Reception pupils will be entitled to a free school meal, although they may have a packed lunch if they wish to. Any Nursery child staying for lunch can purchase a school meal at a cost of £2.50 or alternatively, bring in a packed lunch.



MILK & FRUIT

Each child receives a piece of fruit every day and children under 5 years of age are also entitled to free milk. However, to receive the free milk you must register online www.coolmilk.com and select "register my child for school milk".
